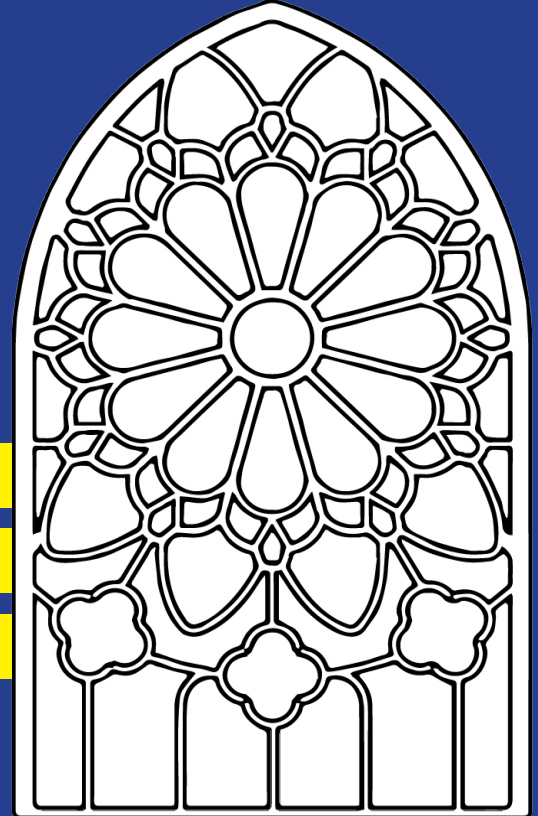


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Saint Andrew's Catholic Church is filled with huge brightly-colored stained glass windows.
